

Tips for Picture Perfect Frames

Choosing images for your frames:

If applying a glaze, use images printed with non water-soluble inks. Images printed with regular ink-jet ink will bleed. Place cropped images in frame with small amount of adhesive and allow to dry.

Glaze and adhesive recommendations:

We tried a few different products, and had good results with *Judi-kins Diamond Glaze* dimensional adhesive and *Aleene's Paper Glaze*.

Avoiding Bubbles:

Before applying glazes/adhesives, squeeze a bit through the tip to release air bubbles from the nozzle. Don't shake the bottle. Should bubbles occur, use a small dry paint brush to carefully pop them. Once the glaze starts to set, bubbles are harder to remove.

Be patient:

Let the glaze dry thoroughly before handling your picture frames. You won't be sorry.

Have fun:

We played with lots of different materials in the frames. Photos, playing cards, postage stamps, buttons, stones, crystals and, of course, beads. The creative options are endless!
