

## **Supplies**

- 1 Amor Button (94-6582-40)
- 4 Jardin Barrel Bead (94-5809-40)
- 13 10mm Large Hole Gemstone Beads (African Turquoise shown)
- 17" 2mm Round Leather Cord (Ant. Red Brown shown)

## **Required Tools**

Scissors, flat nose pliers, super glue

## **Finished Size**

Approx. 8 inches

## **Instructions**

**TIP**: Grasp cord at each end and stretch it before using. This will minimize stretching later.

- 1. Fold one end of cord over 5".
- Form button loop by tying both strands together in an overhand knot, forming a ¾" loop and leaving a 3" tail. (Fig 1)
- String three barrel beads onto cord, covering tail and bringing them next to knot.
- Tie both strands in second overhand knot after last barrel bead. Add small drop of glue into knot and tighten securely.
- String gemstone beads onto long end of cord.

- 6. String final barrel bead.
- Attach button by threading cord through shank, then passing back through barrel bead. (Fig 2)
- Use flat nose pliers to crimp barrel bead until secure. (Option: Add small drop of glue into barrel bead before crimping for added security).
- Trim excess cord at both ends of bracelet.
