Supplies

- 7 Rattlesnake Link (94-3236-18)
- 1 Hammertone Magnetic Clasp (94-6246-18)
- 21 Head Pin 2", 24ga (01-0029-08)
- 8 Round Jump Ring 19ga 5.5mm ID (01-0025-18)
- 7 Round Jump Ring 20ga 4mm ID (01-0024-18)
- 21 Gemstone 4mm Round Bead, Turquoise shown

Required Tools

Chain nose pliers (2), round nose pliers, wire cutters

Finished Size

Approx. 8 inches

Instructions

TIP: Choose different gemstone types to add variety to your "rattles". Best practice with magnetic clasps is to open by sliding them apart instead of pulling them apart.

1. String 1 gemstone bead onto 1 head pin. Use round nose pliers to form wrapped loop, wrapping wire 2-3 times or as desired. Trim excess. Repeat 20 times. Set aside.
2. Arrange rattlesnake links head to tail in a line and use 6 large round jump rings to connect them.
3. Attach 1 small round jump ring to the tail of the first link. Before closing attach 3 gemstone danglers. Close jump ring. Repeat with remaining small jump rings and bead danglers.
4. Use 1 large round jump ring to attach 1 side of the magnetic clasp at one end of the bracelet. Repeat at other end to connect second side of clasp.
