Supplies

- 1 Luna Moth Link Pendant (94-3234-26)
- 1 Nouveau Bail (94-5629-26)
- 2 Flora Ring Small (94-3198-27)
- 2 Distressed Barrel Bead 6x2mm (94-5792-27)
- 21 Turkish 4.5mm Spacer (94-0425-26)
- 1 Head Pin 2" 21ga (01-0028-09)
- 3 Oval Jump Ring 20ga 4x3mm ID (01-0018-09)
- 2 Crimp Bead 2x2mm (01-0030-09)
- 1 Yellow Gemstone Nugget bead 8mm (Yellow Hematoid Quartz shown)
- 36 Tiger's Eye Faceted Gemstone Bead 3mm
- 20 Amethyst Faceted Rondelle Bead 4–5mm
- 20 Peridot Faceted Rondelle Bead 4–5mm
- 32–36" Silk Ribbon
- Fine or Medium Beading Wire

Instructions

TIP: When securing final crimp bead be sure not to make the beaded strand too tight. Allow breathing room for the bail and for the strand to drape nicely.*

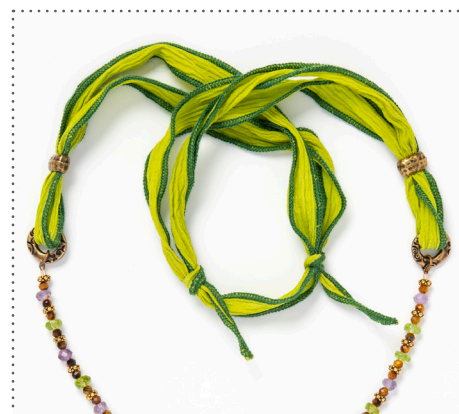
1. String 8mm gemstone bead and 1 Turkish spacer onto head pin. Bend wire over at top of spacer and use round nose pliers to form a 1/8" simple loop, trimming excess wire.
2. Open simple loop and attach at bottom of Luna Moth. Close loop. Set aside.
3. Open 1 jump ring and attach it to 1 Flora ring. Close jump ring. Repeat.
4. Cut one 10–12" piece of beading wire.
5. String on 1 crimp bead onto beading wire. Thread wire through 1 jump ring placed in Step 3.
6. String 1 Turkish spacer, 1 Tiger's Eye bead, 1 Amethyst bead, and 1 Tiger's Eye.
7. String 1 Turkish spacer, 1 Tiger's Eye, 1 Peridot, and 1 Tiger's Eye.
8. Repeat Steps 6–7 three times.
9. Repeat Step 6 once.
10. String 1 spacer, 1 Tiger's Eye, 1 Peridot, then add bail. String 1 Peridot and 1 Tiger's Eye. Repeat Steps 6–7 nine times, then string final spacer.
11. Repeat Step 5, adjusting to take up slack as needed.*
12. Open 1 jump ring and attach to bail loop. Before closing add Luna Moth pendant. Close jump ring.

Required Tools

Chain nose pliers, round nose pliers, crimping pliers, wire cutters

13. String 1 barrel bead onto one end of the silk ribbon. Thread end through ring at one side of beaded strand, then back through barrel bead. Pull through a few inches, then form a sliding knot by tying working end around ribbon in an overhand knot, leaving a 1" tail. (Hint: Aim tail of ribbon towards back of necklace.)
14. Repeat Step 13 on other side.
15. To adjust length, move the sliding knots and adjust ribbon and barrel beads as desired. (Knots at the back of the necklace for a shorter necklace, knots close to Flora rings for a longer necklace.)
